This transfer includes the right to adapt the presentation of the article for use in conjunction with computer systems and programs, including reproduction or publication in machine-readable form and incorporation in retrieval systems.

Authors reserve the following rights:

- Patent and trademark rights to any process or procedure described in the article.
- The right to include the article in full or in part in a thesis or dissertation provided that the thesis or dissertation is not to be published commercially.
- The right to photocopy or make electronic copies of the article for their own personal use, including for their own classroom use, or for the personal use of colleagues, provided that the copies are not offered for sale and are not distributed in a systematic way outside of the employing institutions (e.g., via an e-mail list).
- The right to retain a pre-print version of the article on an electronic public server.
